Total No. of Responses: 137

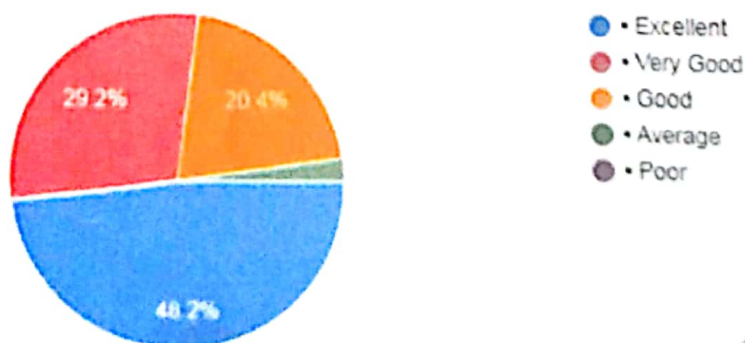

The questionnaire is intended to collect information relating to the satisfaction towards the curriculum, teaching, learning and evaluation from the alumnae. This information will be used as important feedback for the holistic improvement of the institution.


The feedback by alumnae was highly positive. Majority of the alumnae expressed that the curriculum, value added courses were very relevant for their employability or professional growth. 1. How do you rate the courses that you have learnt in the college in relation to your current job / occupation?

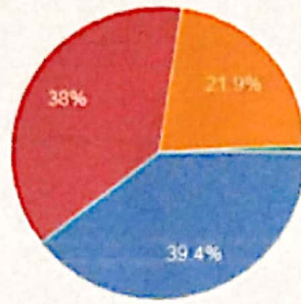


  
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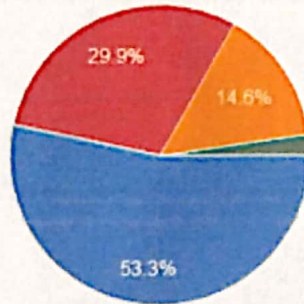

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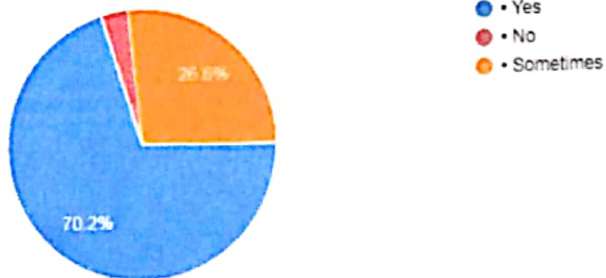

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The feedback analysis clearly indicates that 97% of alumnae were very much satisfied with the admission procedure of the college. They feel proud to be associated with the College as Alumnae and consented that the development activities organized by the College, encouragement and practical exposure given to them contributed to their overall development. 98% of the alumnae showed their likeliness to recommend that the courses they have learnt in the college were very relevant for their employability and exhibited their satisfaction from the faculty, their usage of Innovative teaching and learning materials, illustrative mode of teaching through Group discussion, field exercises, role play etc. 99% of them favored that the availability of reading material (Library), Infrastructure and Lab facilities in the institution facilitated them in their analytical, social and emotional growth. 89% agreed that the canteen facilities were up to the mark. It is observed that 78% of the respondents are already the members of the Alumnae Association of our College.

It was observed that our alumnae feel proud to be associated with the College as the college helped them to be self-disciplined and confident. From here they have learnt time- management and persistent hard work. The alumnae responded that various co-academic activities organized by the College contributed to their overall development.
