Result of Analysis of Students' Feedback (2020-21)

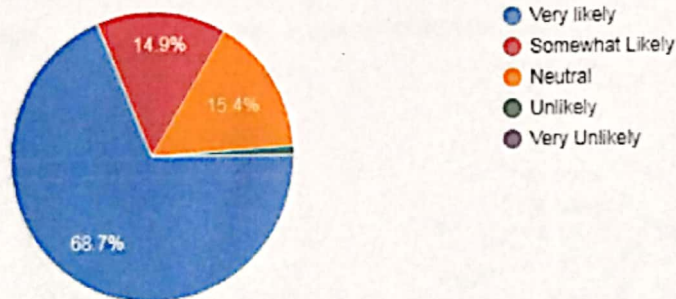
TOTAL STUDENTS: 391

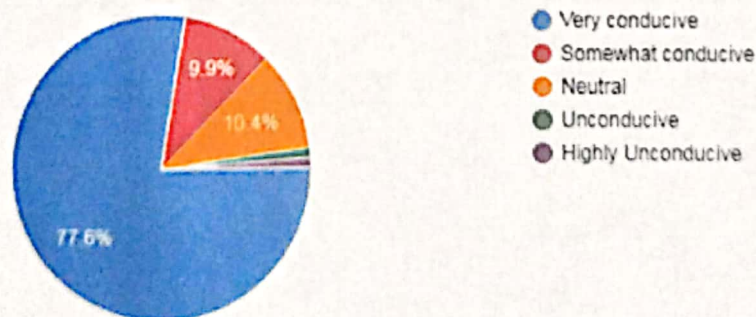


Following is the graphical analysis of each question showing number of students' responses on five-point Likert scale:

1. How likely are you to recommend this college to your friends and family?



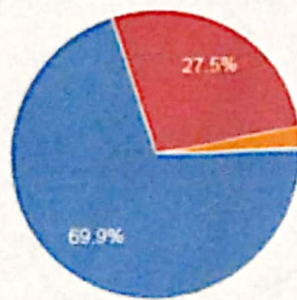
2. How conducive was the learning environment?

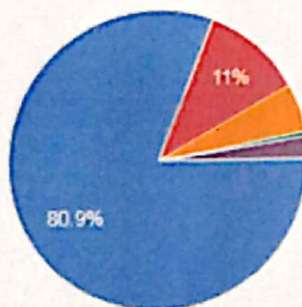

3. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?



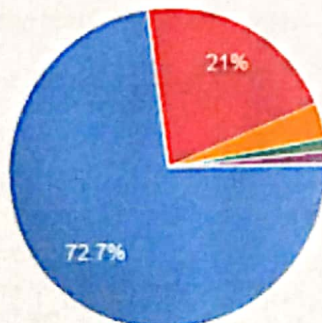

4. How enthusiastic was the teacher about the subject?



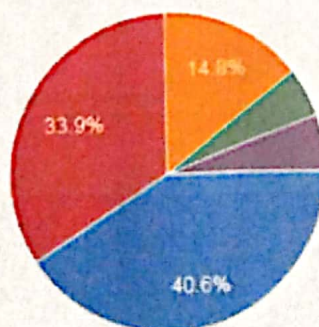

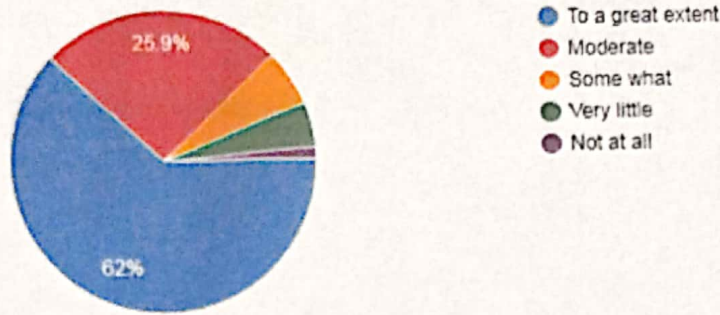

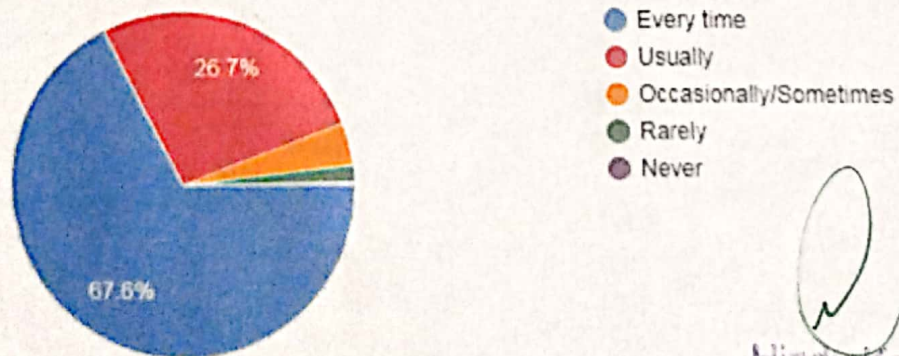
8. The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications.



9. How well does the teacher communicate his or her subjects to the students?



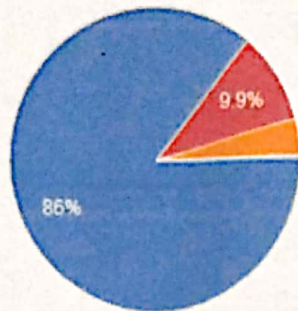
10. How often did you understand the lectures?

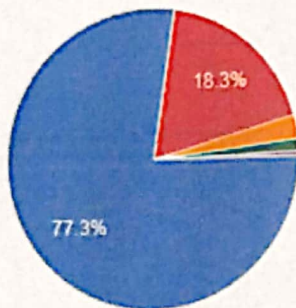

11. How well did the teacher respond to students' queries?



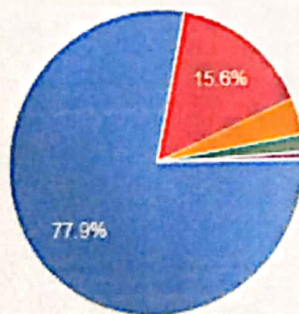

12. The teacher encourages feedback from the students?



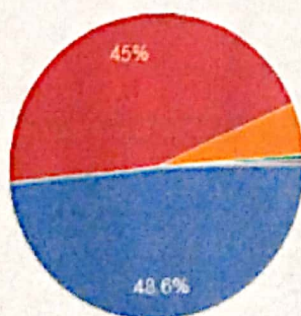

14. The overall quality of teaching-learning process in your institute is very good.

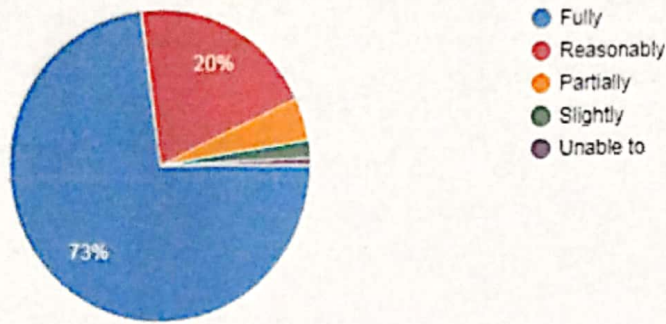

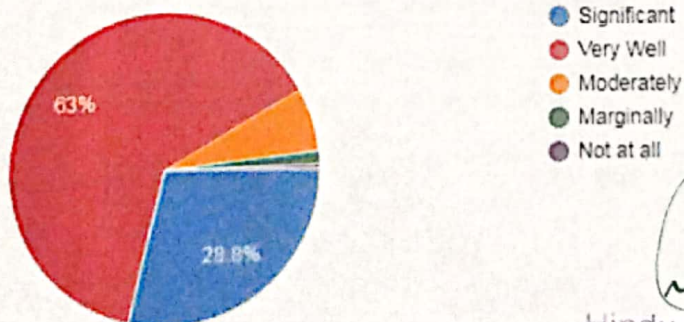
16. Teachers are able to identify your weaknesses and help you to overcome them.

18. The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in analytical, social and emotional growth.



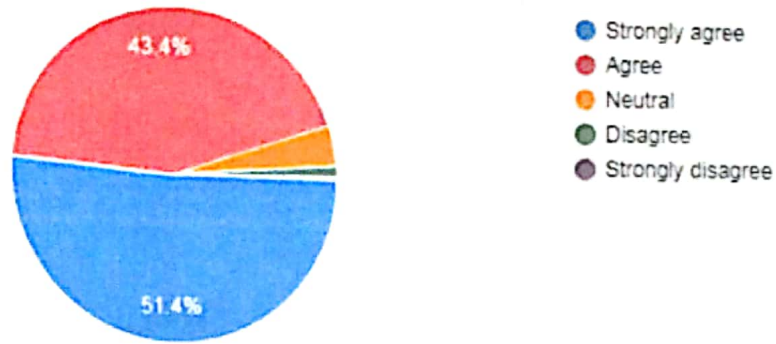


The feedback analysis clearly indicates that more than 90% of students are very much satisfied with conduciveness of learning environment, teachers' enthusiasm to teach their subjects on time, teachers' usage of teaching and learning materials, their illustrative mode of teaching and their genuine concern towards students. 95% of the students consented that encouragement and practical exposure given to them through participation in extra-curricular activities enhanced their confidence and is helpful for overall development. 99% of the students showed their likeliness to recommend this college to their friends and family and 92% of the students favored that the teaching and mentoring process in the institution is facilitating them in their analytical, social and emotional growth. 95% of the students agreed that the multiple opportunities are provided by the institution for their learning and growth.

It is observed that 75% of the students assented that the teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia, etc. more than 70% while teaching. Around 85% of the students were satisfied that the teachers communicate the subjects efficiently and responded to their queries timely. 73% of the students accepted that the teachers identify their strengths and encourage them by giving the right level of challenges.

Our college strives to attain the pinnacle of excellence in academics and co- academic domains and endorses quality assurance in education of women folk in multifaceted areas. It is a matter of great contentment that maximum students have appraised that the learning environment, mode of teaching and practical exposure given to them are commendably gratifying and morale boosting. Thus, to surmount the unprecedented and unavoidable inadequacies in the parameters assessed by the students where they marked certain areas of improvement, there have been some noticeable observations and possible recommendations which are mentioned as under:

- It is therefore pertinent to equip the faculty with the latest teaching methodologies and technologically advanced paradigms to meet the demands of the constantly changing learning environment.


